Description of the US Summary Sheet by State and Market Group

The Apparent Use of Portland Cement U.S. Summary Sheet by State and Market Group report will be available in October following the report year. The report follows the format of this example.

This report provides the best industry estimates for each of the twelve market classifications and the most up-to-date estimates of state total for the report year. It uses annually revised usage factors for many markets and states, and new estimates for non-contract construction. Much of the data needed for this degree of accuracy are not available until late July and August, hence the October publication data. The state totals presented equal the U.S. Bureau of Mines total for shipments by state of destination.
