

FULL-DEPTH RECLAMATION (FDR) WITH PORTLAND CEMENT

A SUSTAINABLE CHOICE IN ROAD REPAIR

- FDR road construction uses deteriorated asphalt pavement combined with cement to create a new stabilized base.
- The new base is stronger, more uniform and more moisture resistant than the original, resulting in a long, low-maintenance life.
- Using FDR with portland cement can reduce the cost of road repair by up to 60 percent.
- There's no need to haul out and dispose of the old material and haul in virgin aggregate, saving natural resources, limited landfill space and reducing truck traffic and emissions.
- The process can be finished in one day and traffic can return to the road almost immediately.
