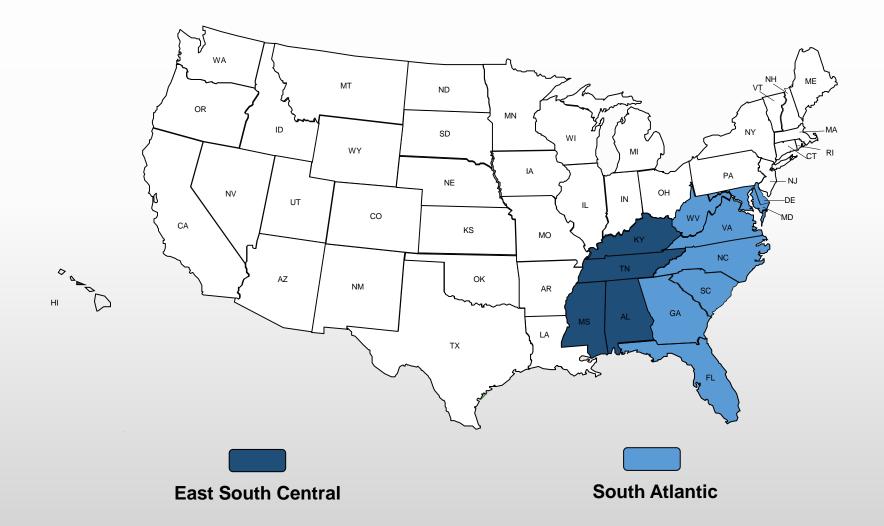

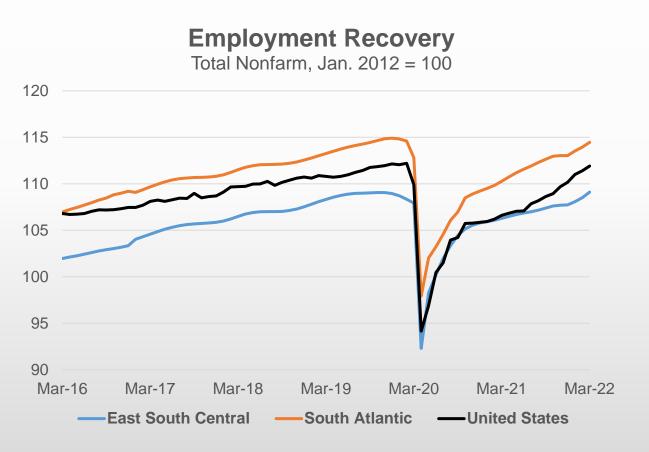


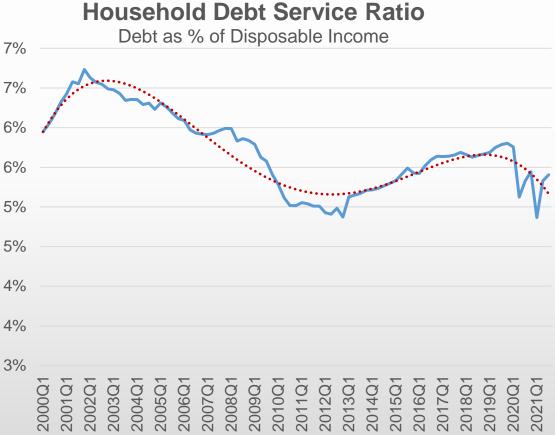

### Households in a strong position



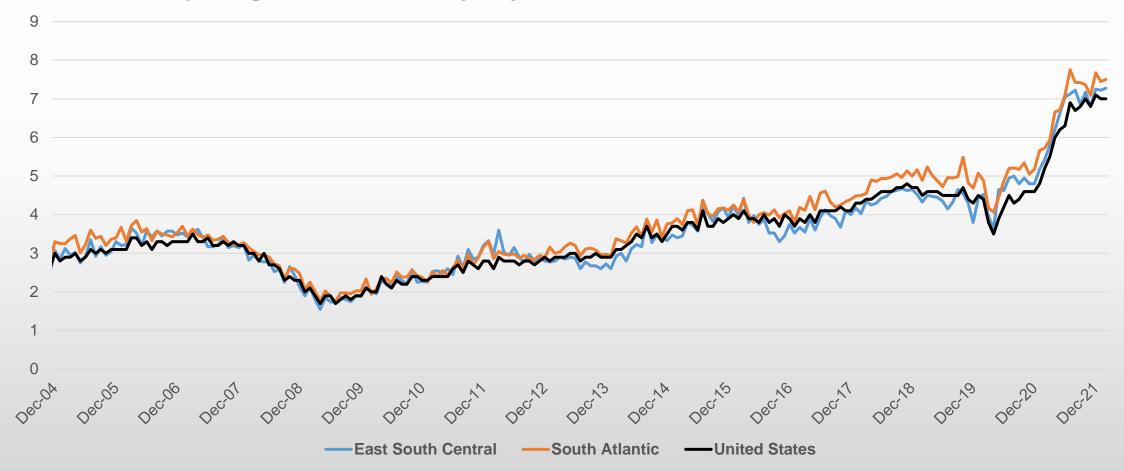

**JOLTS: Job Openings Rate, Seasonally Adjusted** 

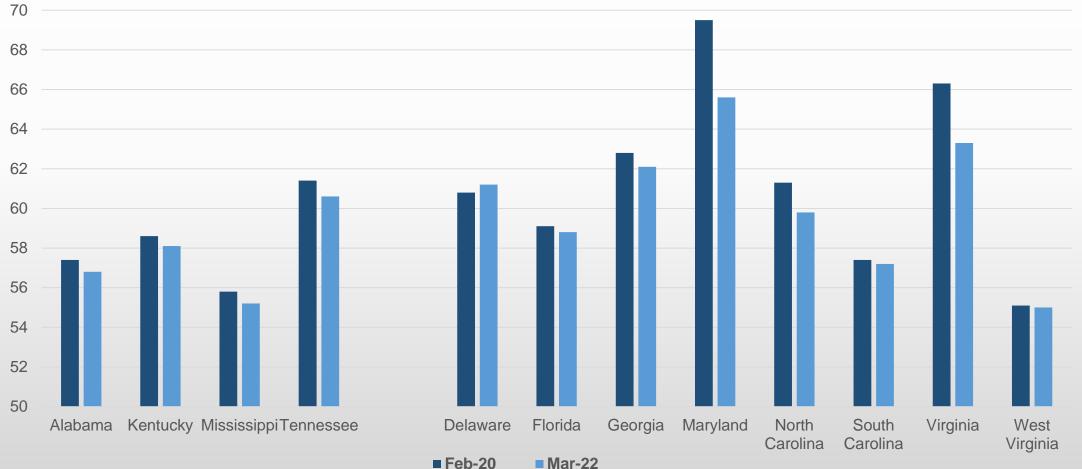

#### **Labor Force Participation Rate**

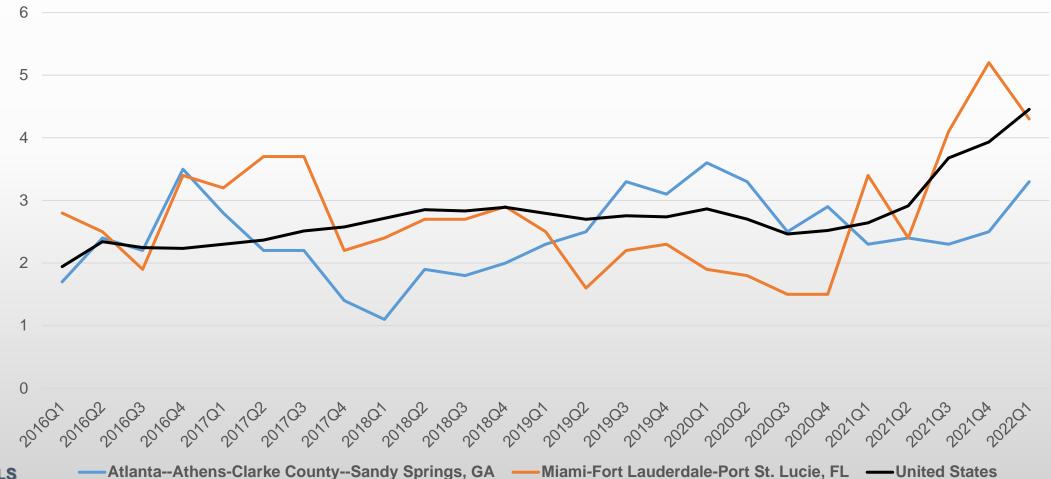

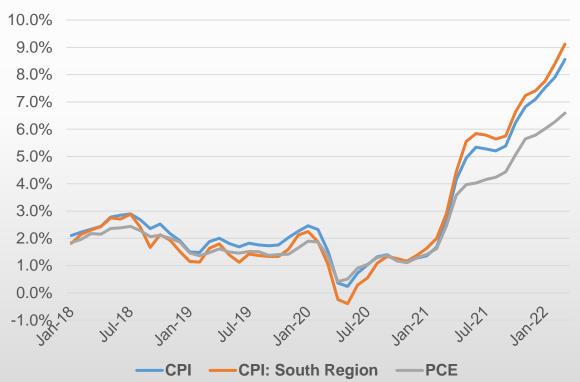

#### **Employment Cost Index – Compensation (Y/Y %)**

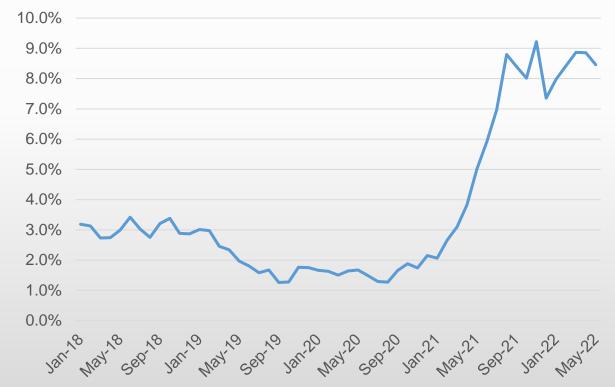

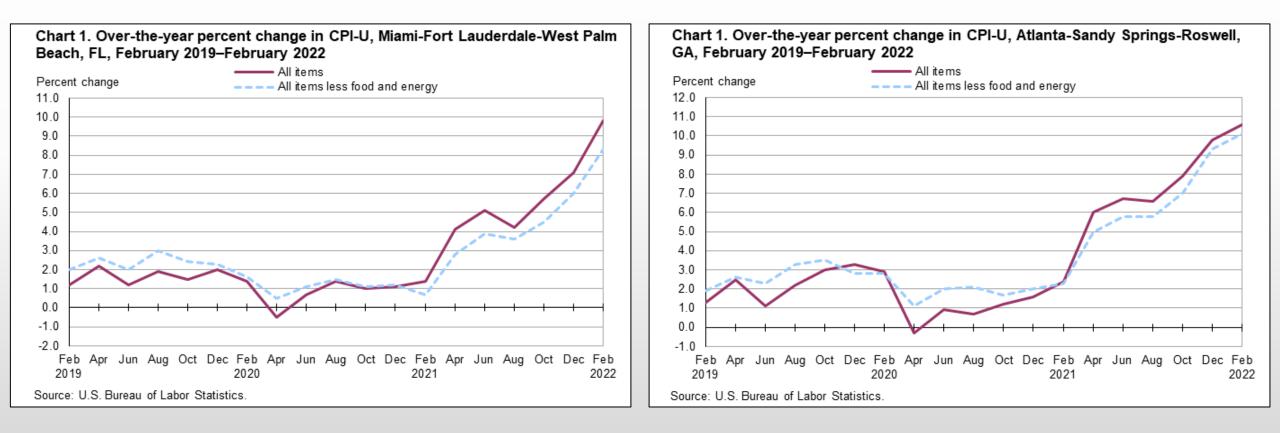

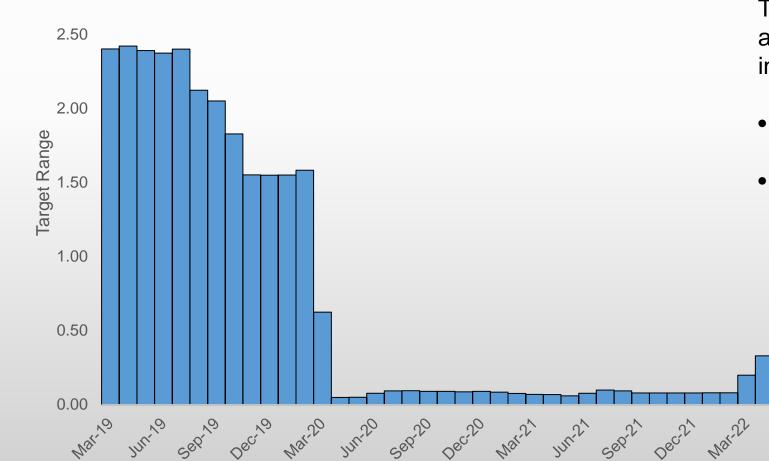
#### **Southeast MSA Level Inflation outpacing national**

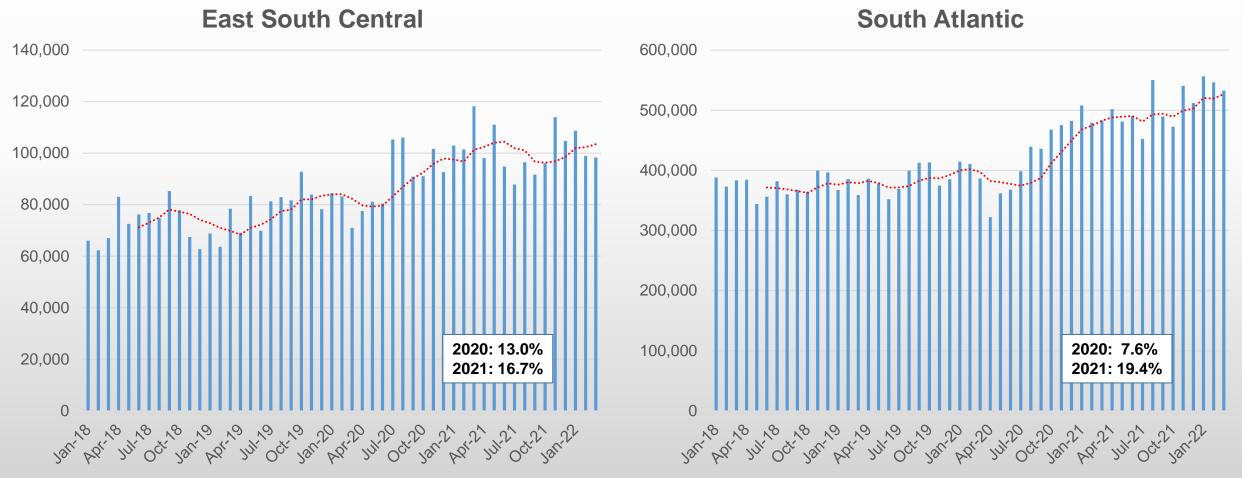

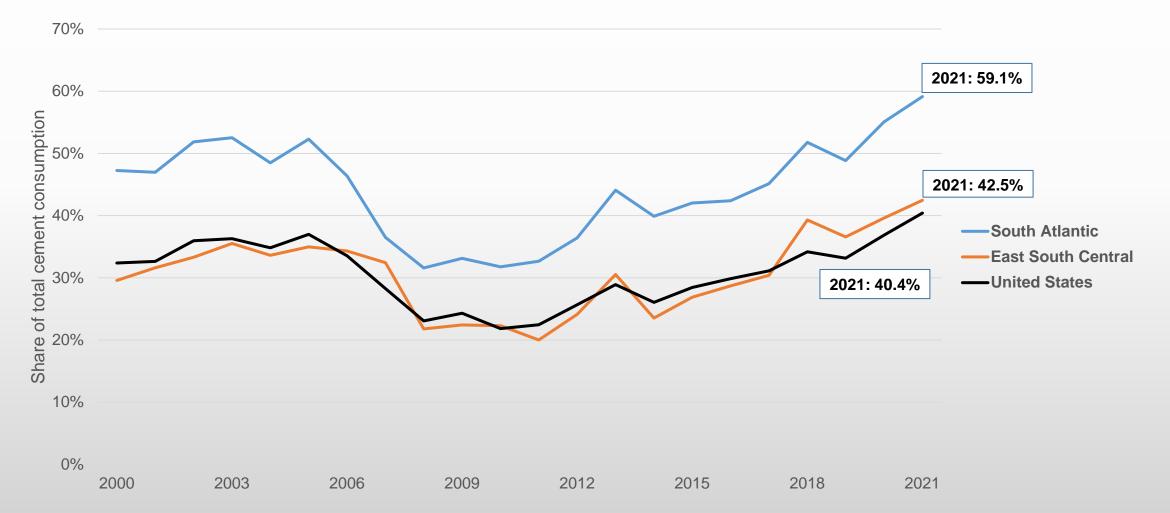
# **Housing Permits: Southeast**

## **Residential Cement Share: Historic Levels**

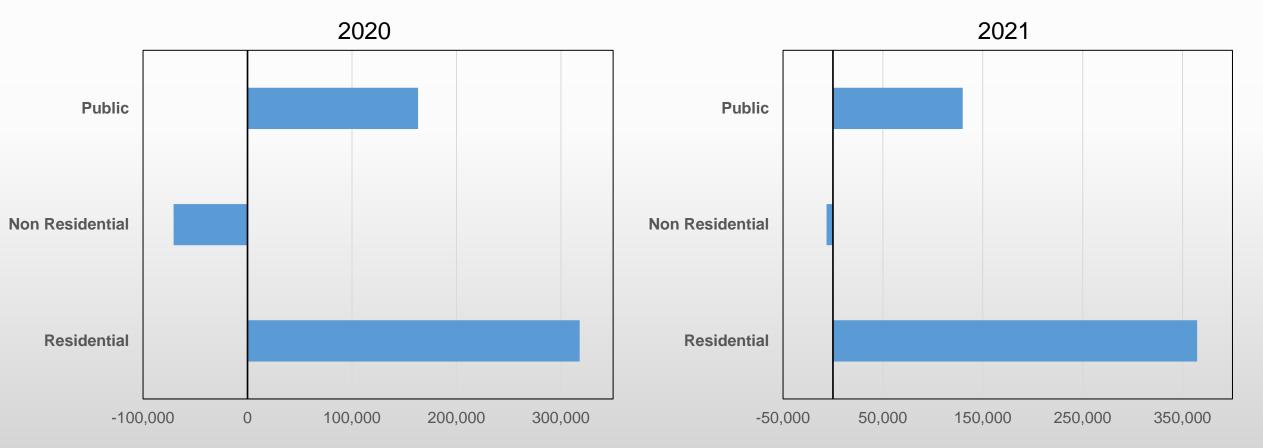

#### East South Central, Consumption Contribution (MT)

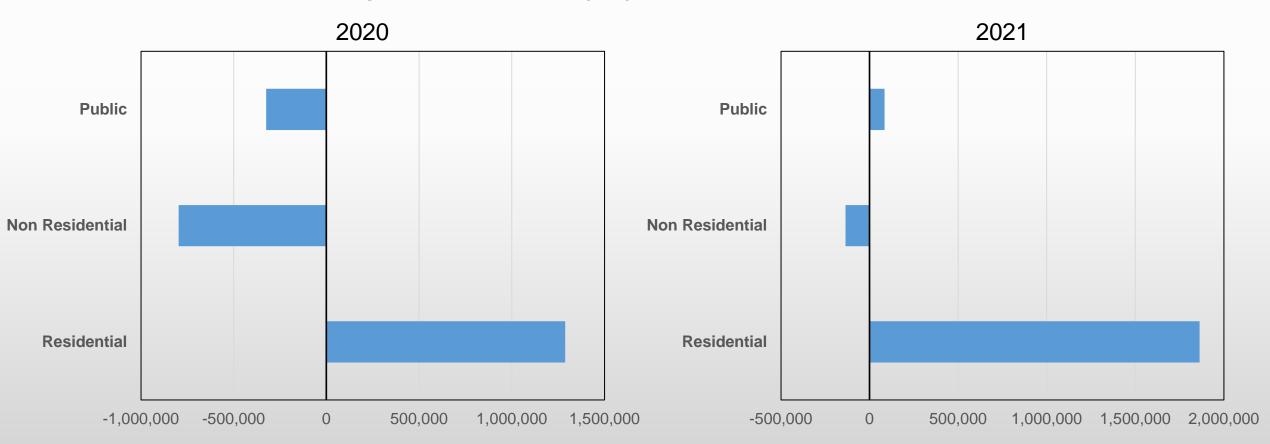

South Atlantic, Consumption Contribution (MT)



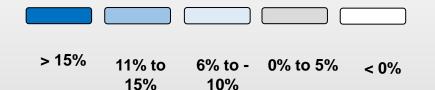

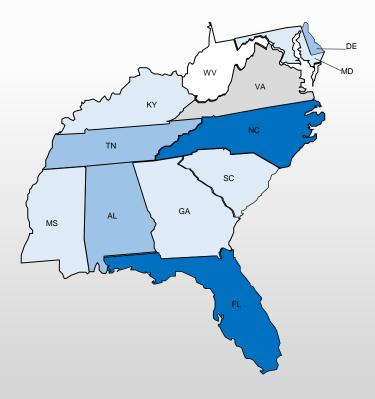


# **Affordability Erosion Impacts**

- Average increase from 2017 to 2019 for this region was 1.2%

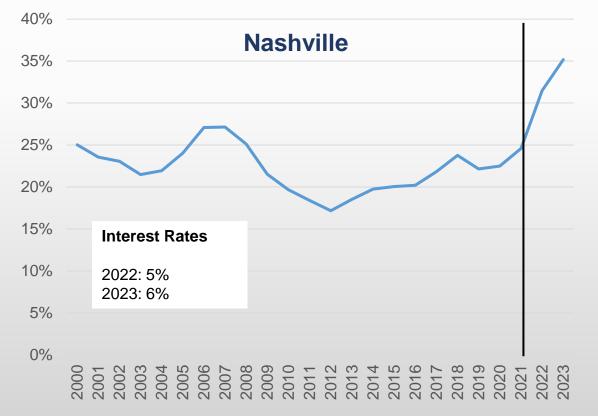






# **Affordability Erosion Impacts**

Higher Interest Rate Scenario: Annual Mortgage Payments Share of Household Income



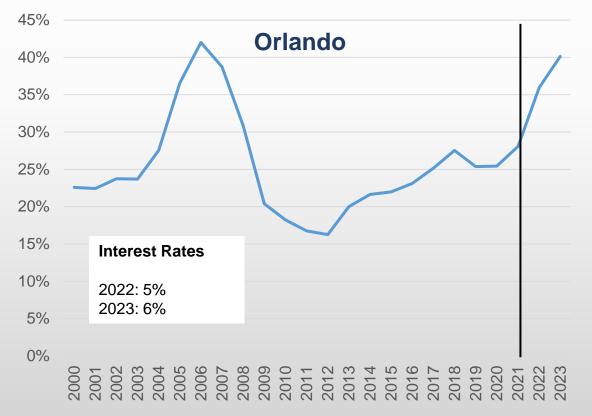


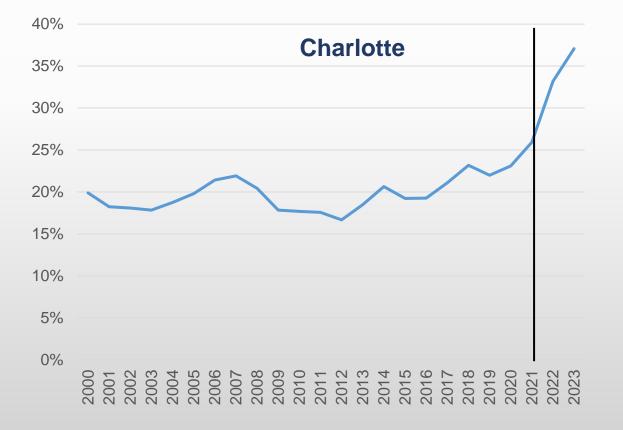

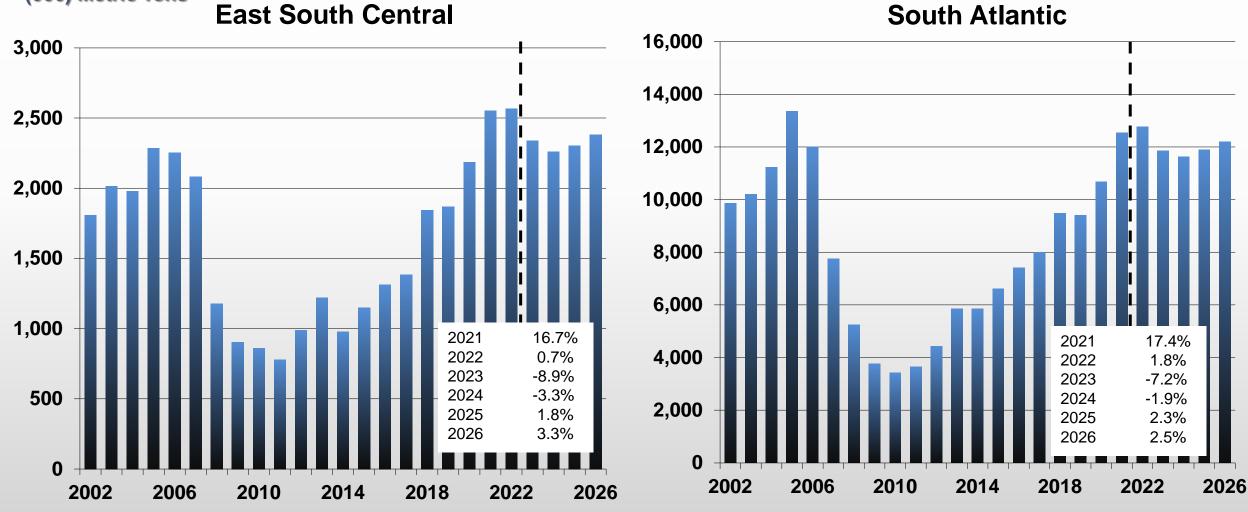

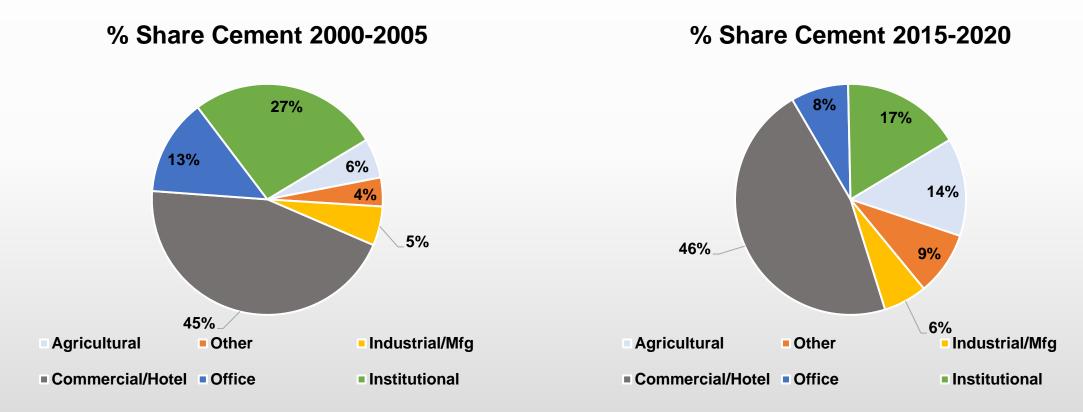

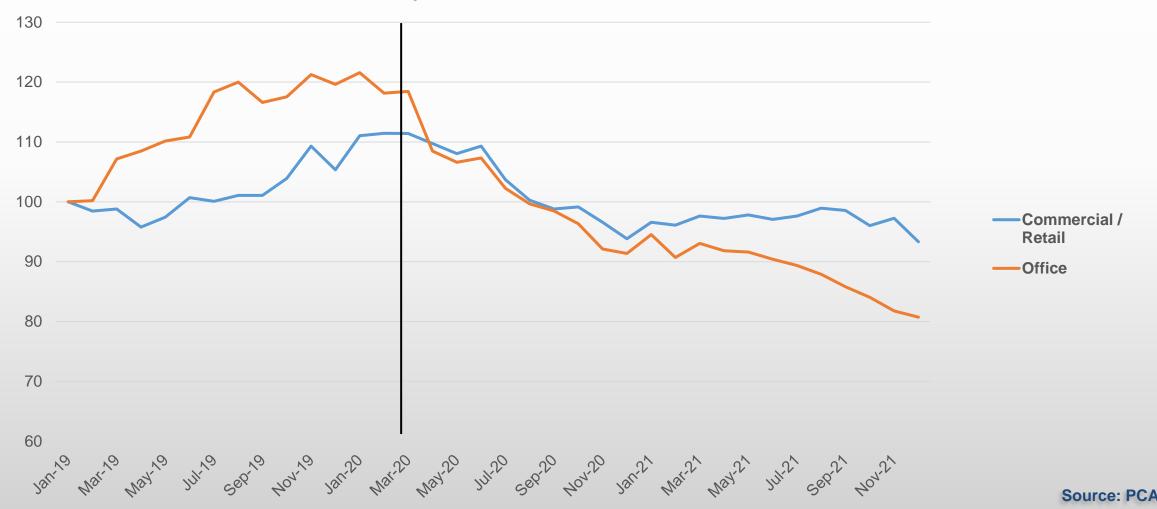


### **Nonresidential Cement Consumption Share: Southeast**

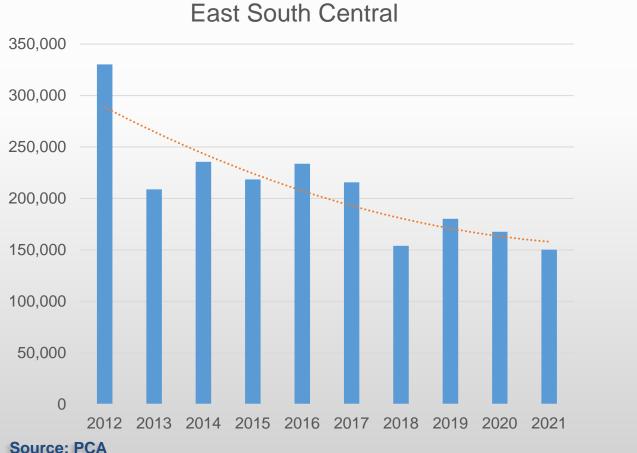
Southeast Put-in-Place Construction Spend, \$1996, Jan. 2019=100

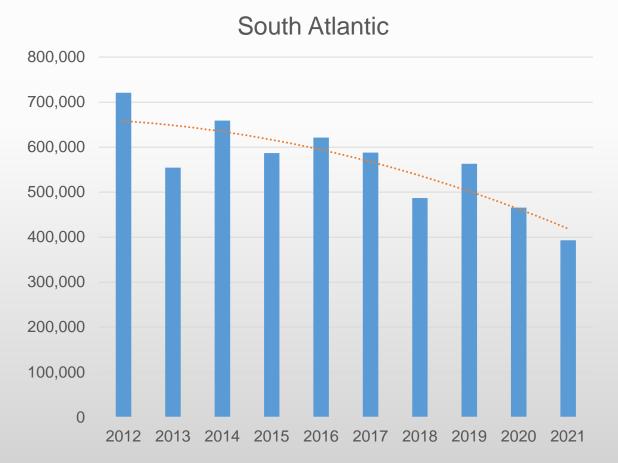

#### **Institutional Buildings Cement Consumption**

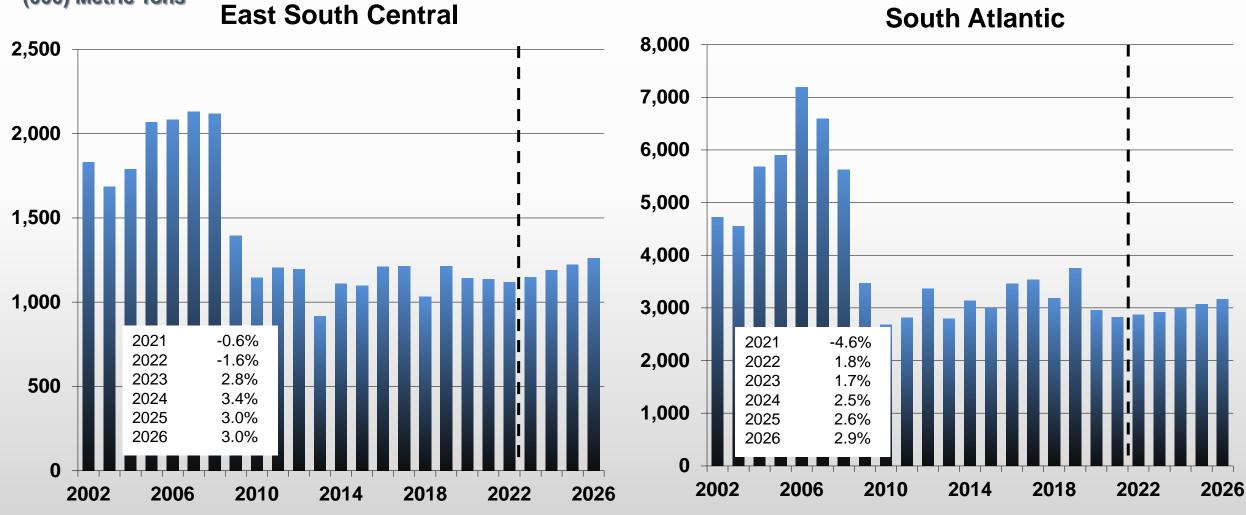

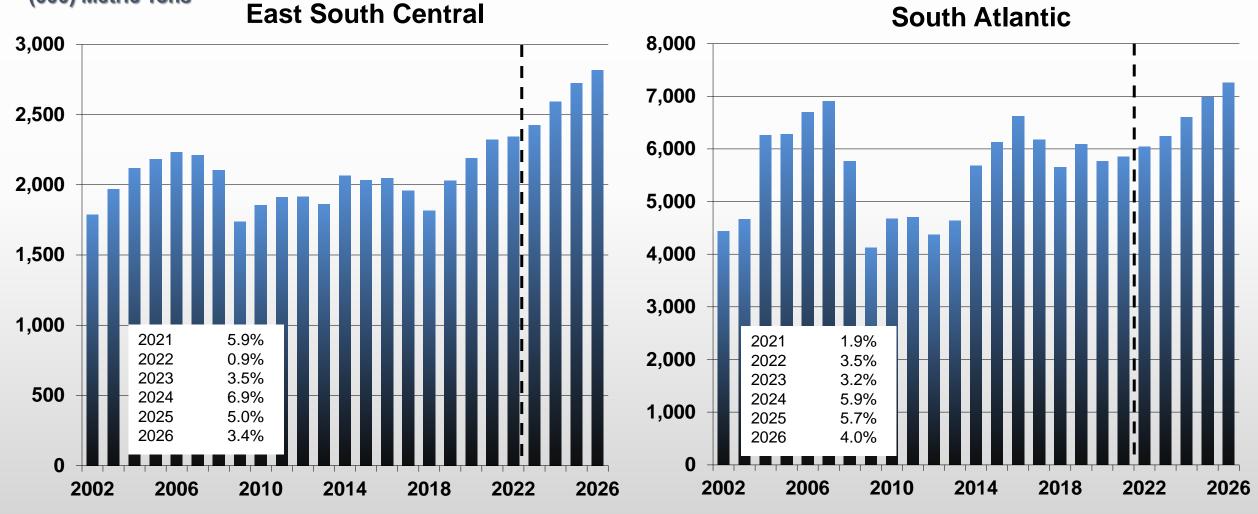

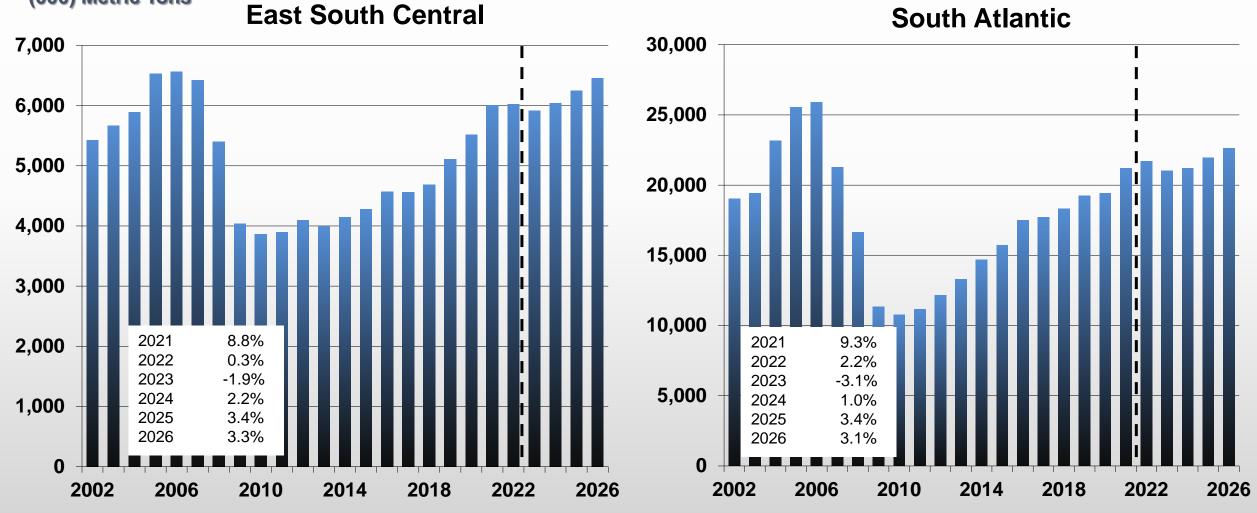
