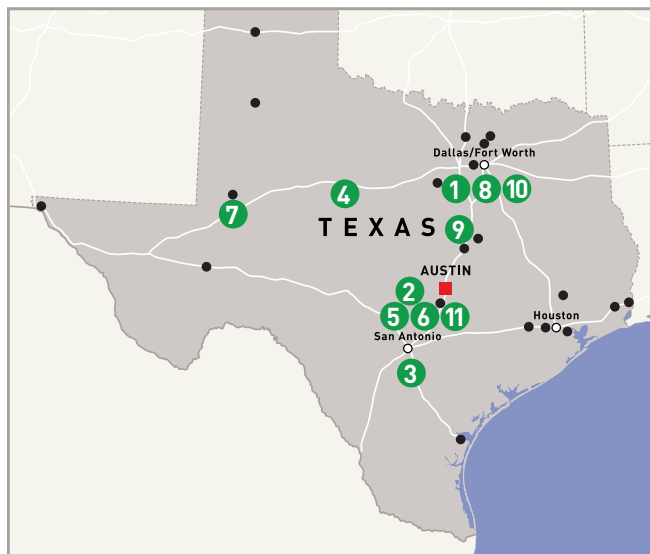

- Cement and related economic contribution to state: **\$20.7 billion**
- Cement and related employees: 24,084 with a payroll of **\$1.4 billion**
- Cement employees: 1,844 with a payroll of **\$159.6 million**
- Cement and related industries' contribution to state tax revenue: **\$241.9 million**
