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Executive Summary

According to the latest U.S. Geological Survey data, shipments of Portland Cement increased by year-over-year in year to date shipments are down cement and for imports declined in from the prior year, driven primarily by declining linked imports, which to just metric tons, a decrease year-over-year.

U.S. construction spending, adjusted for 2019 prices, declined year-over-year in ending a -month streak of consecutive growth. The downturn was driven primarily by a % contraction in real residential investment, with multifamily and home improvement spending declining %, respectively. Nonresidential construction also softened, falling year-over-year, as industrial spending contracted for the first time in four years. Public construction spending remained flat, rising % from year.

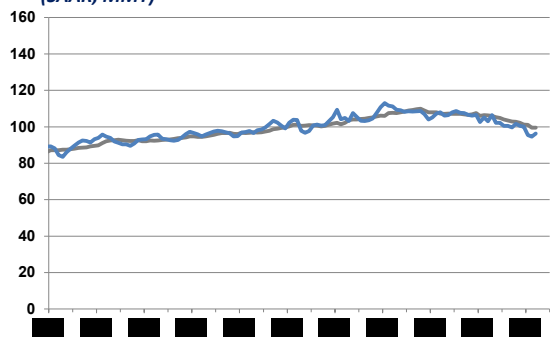

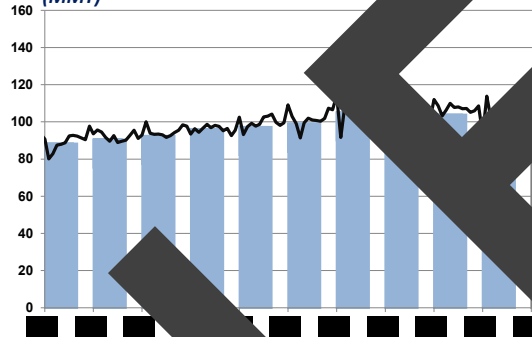

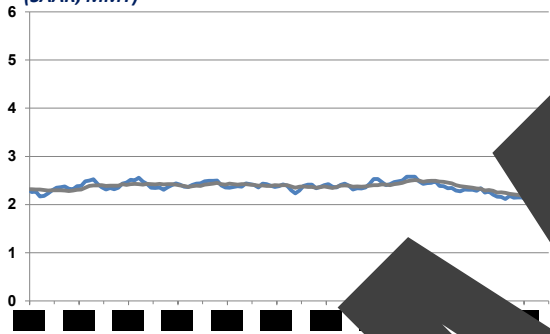

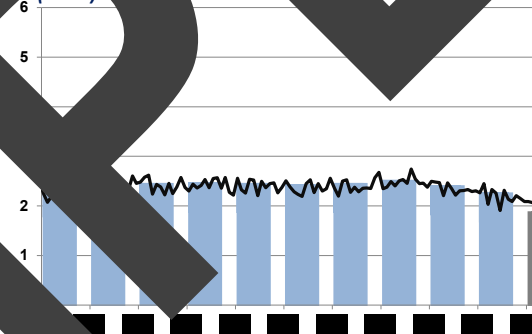

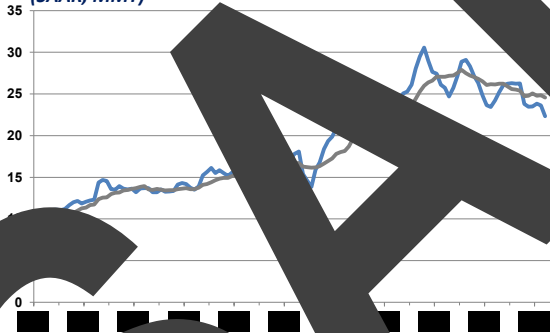
Masonry Cement

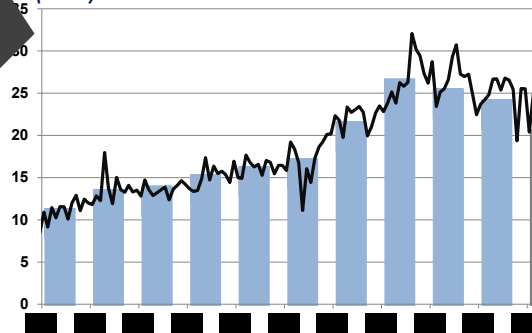

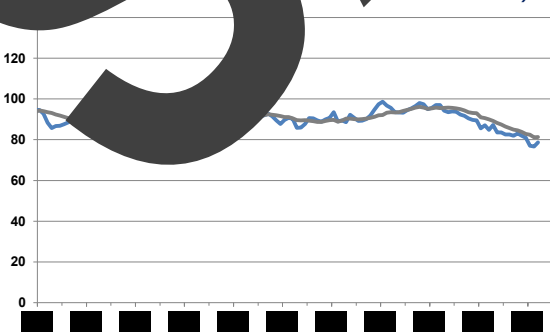
Cement and Clinker Imports

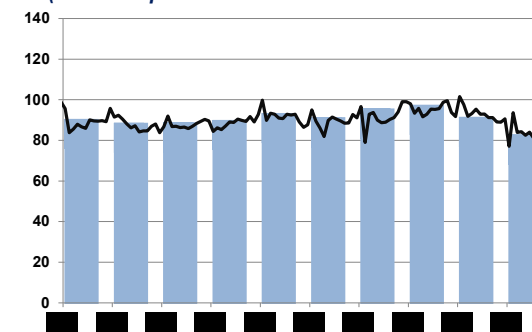

(000 Tons per Real 2009 Billion Construction Dollars)

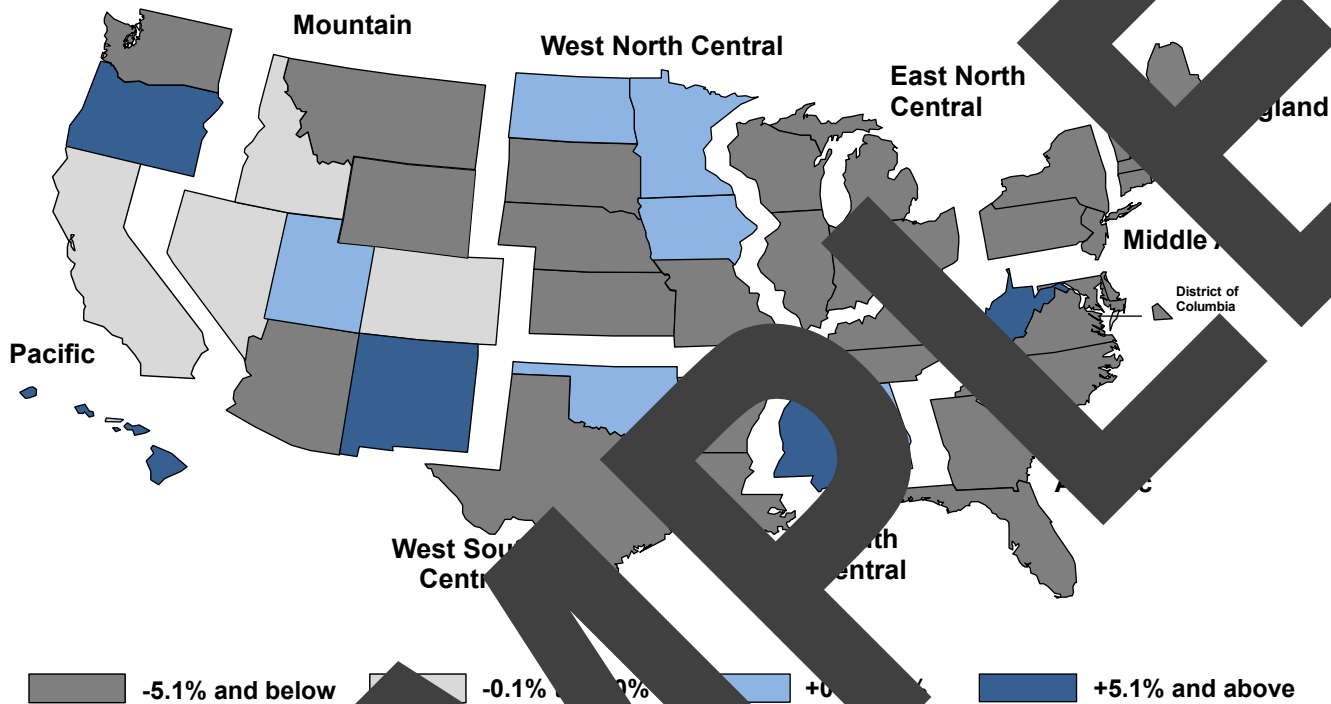

Production of Portland Cement

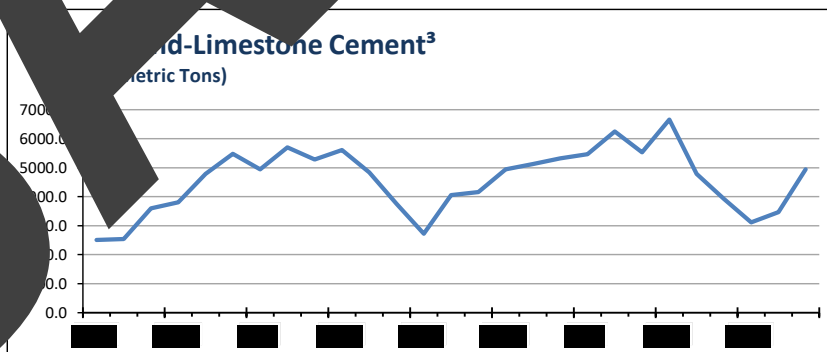
